ORDER MODIFYING THE MINIMUM FLOW PROVISIONS OF THIS COURT'S MEMORANDUM DECISION OF JULY 23, 1979

This matter comes on for hearing in relation to the 13 Spokane Tribe of Indians' (Tribe) Second "Cause of Action," as 14 set forth in the Tribe's Petition of May 28, 1986, which 15 relates to a request by the Tribe to modify the minimum flow 16 originally established by the "Memorandum Opinion and Order" 17 of Judge Marshall Neill, dated July 23, 1979, and reaffirmed 18 by the "Memorandum and Order Granting, In Part, Motions to 19 Amend Memorandum Opinion and Order" of Judge Justin L. 20 Quackenbush, dated August 23, 1982. On the basis of (1) an 21 agreement between the plaintiffs Tribe and United States of 22 America, and defendant State of Washington recommending 23 modification of the minimum flow established in the aforenoted 24 Memorandum Opinion and Order of July 23, 1979, (2) prior 25

notice of said recommended modification having been provided to all parties together with a notice of an opportunity to the parties to present their views and objections to this Court, orally or in writing, as to the recommended modification, and (3) the Court having neither heard nor otherwise received any formal objections to the recommended modification, now, therefore;

As to the minimum flow established on page 10 of Memorandum Decision of Judge Marshall Neill, dated July 23, 1979, and affirmed on page 7 of the Memorandum Decision of Judge Justin L. Quackenbush, dated August 23, 1982, said minimum flow is modified as follows:

1. In relation to all water rights recognized as 15 existing as set forth on pages 13 and 14 of Judge Neill's 16 Memorandum Decision of July 23, 1979 and continuing to exist 17 on the date of this order, including those embodied in permits 18 or certificates issued by the Department of Ecology after the 19 entry of said Memorandum Decision, the presently decreed 20 minimum flow (which provides for a maximum temperature of 68 21 degrees Fahreheit but never less than 20 c.f.s.) is modified 22 to a minimum flow which is 24 c.f.s. regardless of 23 temperature; and 24 25 26 ORDER MODIFYING THE MINIMUM

In relation to water rights (with a priority date on or before September 13, 1988) established subsequent to the entry of this Order pursuant to state law by the State of Washington, Department of Ecology, said rights shall be subject to a minimum flow of 24 c.f.s. regardless of temperature.

8 3. In relation to all other water rights established
9 subsequent to the entry of this order pursuant to state law by
10 the State of Washington, Department of Ecology, said rights
11 shall be subject to a minimum flow of 27 c.f.s. regardless of
11 temperature.

4. For the purposes of this order, "minimum flow of 24
cfs" and "minimum flow of 27 cfs" shall be determined by
calculating the average of the daily average flows of the
previous seven days.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

As to all water rights established under state law 1. 18 subsequent to the entry of the Memorandum Opinion and Order by 19 Judge Neill on July 23, 1979 and the entry of this order and 20 issued to and now held by persons or entities that are not 21 parties to this proceeding, the defendant, State of 22 Washington, is directed (with the concurrence of the holders 23 thereof) to modify any of said rights which include a minimum 24 flow provision therein to a minimum flow of 24 c.f.s. 25 26 ORDER MODIFYING THE MINIMUM
