

Compiler's notes. A former section, which comprised Cr. Prac. 1864, § 664; R.S., R.C., & C.L., § 8207; C.S., § 9174; I.C.A., § 19-3302 was repealed by S.L. 1971, ch. 143, § 5, effective January 1, 1972, and the present section was added by S.L. 1972, ch. 336, § 10 effective April 1, 1972, in the same words as the section prior to its repeal.

Section 9 of S. L. 1972, ch. 336 is compiled as § 19-2601.

Section 11 of S. L. 1972, ch. 336 read: "Any laws of Idaho, other than this Code; that is Title 18 and the amended additional Sections to Title 19, remaining in force after the effective date of this act, which refer to certain provisions of law repealed under this act, shall be deemed to refer to those provisions of this act which are in substance the same or substantially the same as such repealed provisions."

Section 12 of S. L. 1972, ch. 336 read: "This act shall not impair or affect any act done, offense committed or right accruing, accrued,

or acquired or liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred prior to time this act takes effect, but the same may be enjoyed, asserted and enforced, prosecuted or inflicted, as fully and to the same extent as if this act bad not been passed."

Section 13 of S. L. 1972, ch. 336 read: "If any chapter, section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, part or provision of this act shall be found to be invalid or ineffective by any court, it shall be conclusively presumed that this act would have been passed by the legislature without such invalid chapter, section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, part or provision, and this act as a whole shall not be declared invalid by reason of the fact that one or more chapters, sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, parts or provisions may be so found invalid."

19-3501. When action may be dismissed. — The court, unless good cause to the contrary is shown, must order the prosecution or indictment to be dismissed, in the following cases:

(1) When a person has been held to answer for a public offense, if an indictment or information is not found against him and filed with the court within six (6) months from the date of his arrest.

(2) If a defendant, whose trial has not been postponed upon his application, is not brought to trial within six (6) months from the date that the information is filed with the court.

(3) If a defendant, whose trial has not been postponed upon his application, is not brought to trial within six (6) months from the date that the defendant was arraigned before the court in which the indictment is found.

(4) If a defendant, charged with a misdemeanor offense, whose trial has not been postponed upon his application, is not brought to trial within six (6) months from the date that the defendant enters a plea of not guilty with the court.

(5) If a defendant, charged with both a felony or multiple felonies and a misdemeanor or multiple misdemeanors together in the same action or charging document, whose trial has not been postponed upon his application, is not brought to trial within six (6) months from the date that the information is filed with the court.

(6) If a defendant, charged with both a felony or multiple felonies and a misdemeanor or multiple misdemeanors together in the same action or charging document, whose trial has not been postponed upon his application, is not brought to trial within six (6) months from the date that the defendant was arraigned before the court in which the indictment is found. Reasonable delays. Speedy trial. Waiver of right.

Application

Time After Indictment or Information. This section addresses only the length of time elapsing after an indictment or information is filed; it does not refer to any period following a remittitur from an appeal after a trial once has been held. State v. Scroggie, 114 ldaho 188, 755 P.2d 485 (Ct. App. 1988).

Burden on State.

When a criminal defendant makes a prima facie showing that his right to a speedy trial is violated under this section, the burden is on the state to show good cause for the delay, just as the primary responsibility for bringing a case to trial is upon the state. State v. Hobson, 99 Idaho 200, 579 P.2d 697 (1978).

Constitutionality.

The right to a speedy trial has been enhanced, not diminished, by subdivision (3) of this section; therefore, this subdivision is constitutionally sound without retroactive application to cases pending on its effective date. State v. Brooks, 109 Idaho 726, 710 P.2d 636 (Ct. App. 1985).

Constitutional Rights.

Defendant's constitutional right to a speedy trial is a trial as soon as reasonably possible.

Ex parte Rash 64 Idaho 521, 134 P.2d 420 (1943).

The term "speedy trial" means that one accused of crime should be tried not later than the next term of court subsequent to being held to answer, unless the trial is delayed on defendant's application, or postponed with his consent or other tawful valid reason.

Filenwood v. Cramer, 75 Idaho 338, 272 P.2d. 702 (1954).

Under constitutional provisions providing for a speedy trial, "speedy trial," being of indeterminate meaning, is subject to construction by the legislature which must be read in connection with the constitutional provision and be given effect as a legislative definition of what constitutes a "speedy trial." Schrom v. Cramer, 76 Idaho 1, 275 P.2d 979 (1954).

Any delay caused by the defendant's resistance to extradition is tolled for the purposes of a speedy trial. Balla v. State, 97 Idaho 378, 544 P.2d 1148 (1976).







This being the time fixed by the Court for pronouncing sentence upon the defendant, ALBERT R. MOORE, the Court noted the presence of the Prosecuting Attorney, or his deputy, the defendant, and J. Layne Davis, counsel for the defendant, in court.

The defendant was duly informed of the Information filed against him, and the defendant entered an *Alford* plea of guilty to the crime of COUNT I: OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL (TWO OR MORE WITHIN TEN YEARS), a felony under I.C. §18-8004, 8005(5) committed on or about September 3, 2006.

The defendant, and his counsel, were then asked if they had any legal cause or

 reason to offer why judgment and sentence should not be pronounced against the defendant, and if the defendant, or his counsel, wished to make a statement on behalf of the defendant, or to present any information to the Court in mitigation of punishment; and the Court, having accepted such statement, and having found no legal cause or reason why judgment and sentence should not be pronounced against the defendant at this time; does render its judgment of conviction as follows, to-wit:

That, whereas, the defendant having pled guilty in this Court to the crime of COUNT I: OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL (TWO OR MORE WITHIN TEN YEARS), a felony under I.C. §18-8004, 8005(5).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the defendant, ALBERT R. 
COMES NOW, R. Scott Bandy, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney for the County of Ada, State of Idaho, and moves this Court to amend the judgment of conviction in the above entitled case to correct an apparent clerical mistake. The court, upon remand from the Idaho Supreme Court, entered an amended judgment, which affirmed the original judgment. This followed a review of the original judgments of conviction showing the requisite prior

convictions for Driving Under the Influence for the instant Felony Driving Under the Influence conviction. The Amended Judgment entered by the court on June 9th, 2010, pronounced the sentence to be: a minimum period of confinement of one (1) year, followed by a subsequent indeterminate period of custody not to exceed four (4) years. This is in error and misstates the original sentence that was reaffirmed by the court on that date. Attached is copy of the original Judgment of Conviction entered on December 31st, 2008, pronouncing the judgment to be: a minimum period of confinement of one (1) year, followed by a subsequent indeterminate period of custody not to exceed five (5) years for a total aggregate term of 6 years. (Attachment "A"). The state respectfully requests that the amended judgment be corrected to reflect the original sentence.

Additionally, the state requests that the defendant's credit for time served be corrected to reflect the actual number of days served pre-judgment. In support of this request the state offers the following for consideration. The court as indicated above, entered the original judgment of conviction on December 31st, 2008. At that time, the defendant's credit for pre-judgment credit was calculated by the court to be eight hundred and forty eight (848) days. The original information on file in this case alleges the date of incident for the crime was September 3rd, 2006. The defendant pled guilty as charged. While there were eight hundred and forty eight (848) day between the date of incident and the date of sentencing, much of that time was not spent in custody. During one extended period of release, the defendant committed his subsequent Felony DUI. Giving the defendant the benefit of the doubt and crediting every day spent in custody toward both

custody.







PROCEEDINGS

This matter came on before the Court based upon a proposed Order from Albert Moore for a Rule 35 hearing. The Court had entered a Second Amended Judgment of Conviction on October 14, 2010. The defendant has been sentenced to the State Penitentiary for a fixed term of one (1) year and indeterminate term of five (5) years for a total of six (6) years.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Court had earlier granted the defendant credit for time served in the Ada County Jail for eight hundred forty-eight (848) days. The Court, upon review of the actual detention time served on this case, determined that the correct number of days of credit would be four hundred seventy-seven (477) days for time served as of October

7, 2010.

The defendant has asked that his sentence be corrected or changed primarily based upon the Court's calculation of credit for time served. However, in addition, the defendant asks that his sentence be reduced to one (1) year fixed plus four (4) years indeterminate, with eight hundred forty-eight (848) days of credit.

ANALYSIS

Rule 35 provides:

(M)otions to correct or modify sentences under this rule must be filed within 120 days of the entry of the judgment imposing sentence or order releasing retained jurisdiction and shall be considered and determined by the court without the admission of additional testimony and without oral argument, unless otherwise ordered by the Court in its discretion...

Defendant requests his sentence be reduced for the reasons set forth above. The determination to grant or deny the relief requested by Defendant is a matter committed to the Court's discretion. See State v. Gardner, 127 Idaho 156, 164, 989 P.2d 615 (Ct. App. 1995) Appellate courts employ the same standard of review on a court's determination of whether to grant a motion for reduction of sentence as the court's original imposition of sentence. See State v. Ricks, 120 Idaho 875 (Ct. App. 1991) The Court has engaged in the analysis set forth in State v. Toohil, 103 Idaho 565, 650 P.2d 707 (Ct. App. 1982).

The Court will decline to grant the defendant's request for a reduction of sentence. The defendant is a life-long alcoholic who has, on multiple occasions, chosen to become intoxicated and drive motor vehicles. He has more than one felony conviction for driving under the influence of alcohol. The defendant has not been

amenable to community based treatment and/or has not practiced the community based treatment that he has been provided with.

For these reasons, the Court DENIES Defendant's Motion for Reduction of Sentence pursuant to I.C.R. 35.
