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

Plaintiff hereby complains of Defendants as follows:

1. This is an action under the Uniform Fraudulent Transfer Act, Title 55, Chapter 9 of the Idaho Code. In anticipation of judgment, Defendants Gordon A. and Linda G. Jones formed a limited liability company and transferred real property located in Franklin County, Idaho to that LLC. This action seeks to avoid the transfer, attach the property and enjoin further disposition by Defendants of the Franklin County property or of other property.

PARTIES AND JURISDICTION

2. Plaintiff Allen Grazer is an individual residing in Davis County, State of Utah.

3. Defendants Gordon A. Jones and Linda G. Jones (collectively "Jones") are husband and wife residing in Davis County, State of Utah. Prior to December 28, 2004 Jones owned real property in Franklin County, State of Idaho.

4. Defendant J&J Livestock, LLC is a Utah Limited Liability Company in good standing in the state of Utah. J&J Livestock, LLC owns real property in Franklin County, State of Idaho.

Jurisdiction over Defendants is proper under I.C.
 5-514c(c).

6. Venue is proper in this county under I.C. 5-401(1).

GENERAL ALLEGATIONS

7. Beginning in 2002, Jones owned over 200 acres of land in Franklin County, Idaho. These parcels are identified as Parcels Nos. 908.00, 908.01 and 915.00 with the legal description:



COMMENCING AT A POINT 53-3/4 RODS NORTH OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST OF THE BOISE MERIDIAN, FRANKLIN COUNTY, IDAHO, AND RUNNING THENCE WEST 240 RODS, THENCE NORTH 53-3/4 RODS, THENCE EAST 240 RODS; THENCE SOUTH 53-3/4 RODS TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING.

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING A RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR ANY AND ALL IRRIGATION DITCHES AND CANALS, AND PUBLIC ROADS NOW EXISTING OR IN USE UPON AND ACROSS SAID PREMISES, AND EXCEPTING AND RESERVING THEREFROM A STRIP OF LAND 3 RODS WIDE ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF THE ABOVE-DESCRIBED LAND.

ALSO, THE SOUTH HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER, THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER, AND THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST OF THE BOISE MERIDIAN, FRANKLIN COUNTY, IDAHO.

TOGETHER WITH 36 SHARES OF THE CAPITAL STOCK OF TWIN LAKES CANAL COMPANY.

(hereinafter "the Franklin County property").

8. Commencing in 1993 Jones, as general contractor, built a

home for Grazer in Davis County, Utah.

9. On November 1, 2002 Jones initiated litigation against Grazer seeking to collect approximately \$17,000 of unpaid invoices. Grazer counterclaimed alleging construction defects, negligence and breaches of contract and warranty. This action is known as *Gordon Jones and Richard Barney v. Allen Grazer*, Second District Court, Davis County, Farmington Department, State of Utah, Case No. 020700570 CN ("the civil case").

10. The parties commenced the discovery phase of the civil case. In late 2004 Grazer and his experts began to discuss significant construction defects in the home, and began advising counsel for Gordon Jones of the severity of these defects.

11. On December 15, 2004, the Judge in the civil case sent a notice of trial, scheduling the matter for trial on April 26-29, 2005.

12. On December 22, 2004 Jones transferred, by quit claim deed, the Franklin County property to J&J Livestock, LLC. See Exhibit "A" ("the quit claim deed"). The deed was recorded on December 27, 2004.

13. J&J Livestock, LLC was formed in the state of Utah on December 28, 2004.

14. On April 26-29, 2005 Judge Alphin of the Second District Court in Utah heard the civil case. On April 26, 2005 Judge Alphin dismissed the claims brought by Jones and ruled in favor of Grazer on Jones' claims. On April 29, 2005 Judge Alphin declared his preliminary intention to award judgment in favor of Grazer and against Jones on Grazer's counterclaim. That judgment has not yet been entered, pending arguments by counsel respecting the amount of damages to be awarded.

FIRST CLAIM FOR RELIEF (Declaratory Judgment)

15. Grazer realleges and incorporates by reference paragraphs 1 - 14 above.

16. The quit claim deed from Jones to J&J Livestock, LLC was recorded on December 27, 2004.

J&J Livestock, LLC did not exist until December 28,
 2004. See Exhibit "A."

18. The quit claim deed, which purports to transfer all right, title and interest in the Franklin County property is void ab initio.

19. This court has the power under the Uniform Declaratory Judgment Act, I.C. 10-1201 *et seq*. to declare the deed void and to declare title to the Franklin County property remains in Jones, grantors under the quit claim deed.

SECOND CLAIM FOR RELIEF (Uniform Fraudulent Transfer Act)

20. Grazer realleges and incorporates by reference paragraphs 1 - 19 above.

COMPLAINT

21. As manager, member and registered agent, Jones materially controls, and at all times material hereto has controlled, J&J Livestock, LLC.

22. J&J Livestock, LLC was formed for the purpose of holding title to the Franklin County property.

23. Jones' quit claim deed to J&J Livestock, LLC was made at a time in discovery when Jones became aware of the extent of his potential and likely liability to Grazer.

24. Jones transferred the Franklin County property to J&J Livestock, LLC with actual intent to hinder, delay and defraud Grazer in the collection of a judgment.

25. At the time of the quit claim deed, Jones had received Grazer's expert's report, was facing a trial date on Grazer's claims and believed or reasonably should have believed that a judgment was imminent.

26. On information and belief, Jones did not receive a reasonably equivalent value in exchange for the transfer to J&J Livestock, LLC.

27. Grazer is entitled to an avoidance of the transfer to the extent necessary to satisfy his judgment.

6

28. This Court should attach the Franklin County property pursuant to I.C. 55-916(b).

29. Defendants and each of them should be enjoined from further disposing of property, real and personal, held in Franklin County, State of Idaho.

WHEREFORE Plaintiff prays for relief as follows:

 For a declaratory order declaring the quit claim deed void ab initio and vesting title to the Franklin County property in Jones.

2. For judgment avoiding the transfer of the Franklin County property from Jones to J&J Livestock, LLC under the Uniform Fraudulent Transfer Act, I.C. 55-916(a).


3. For a writ of attachment attaching the Franklin County property to satisfy Grazer's judgment against Jones.



2. Beginning in 2002, Plaintiff Grazer and Defendant Gordon A. Jones were in litigation known as Gordon Jones and Richard Barney v. Allen Grazer; Second Judicial District Court Davis County, Farmington Department, Case No. 020700570 CN before Judge Michael G. Allphin

3. In late 2004 Grazer and his experts began to discuss significant construction defects in the home, and began advising counsel for Jones of the severity of these defects. Damages were estimated to be at least \$2.5 Million.

4. On November 30, 2004, a trial date for April 2005 was set by the Court.

5. On December 22, 2004 Jones transferred, by quit claim deed, the Franklin County property to J&J Livestock, LLC. See Exhibit "B" ("the quit claim deed"). The deed was recorded on December 27, 2004.

6. J&J Livestock, LLC was formed in the state of Utah on December 28, 2004. Gordon A. Jones is a member, manager, and registered agent of J&J Livestock, LLC. See Exhibit "C."

7. Upon discovery of the facts in paragraphs 1, 5, and 6 above, Grazer filed a Lis Pendens and Uniform Fraudulent Transfer action in this Court.

8. After filing this action, J&J Livestock, LLC was registered in the State of Idaho on May 23, 2005. Mr. Jones' son, Jason Jones, is the registered agent in Idaho for the company. See Exhibit "D."

9. Jones has sworn under oath that "if necessary" he is willing to "stipulate and agree that my interest in the Apartment Building, **the Idaho Property** owned by J&J Livestock, and the West Bountiful Property is subject to levy in the event the Court establishes an obligation." Affidavit of Gordon Jones, dated June 1, 2005, paragraph 32. (Emphasis Added.)¹

ARGUMENT

A. PREJUDGMENT WRIT OF ATTACHMENT

Under I.C. 55-916(b), all of the requirements for a prejudgment writ of attachment are all met in this case. This writ is sought for the purpose of preventing dissipation of assets and not for the purpose of hindering, delaying, or defrauding any other creditor. I.C. 8-503(3); Affidavit of Allen F. Grazer, 2. Mr. Jones and the transferrees in this case

¹ Immediately after learning that the Judge in the Utah case declared his preliminary intention to award judgment in favor of Grazer and against Jones and Barney on Grazer's counterclaim, Jones and Barney transferred their interest in a Utah Apartment Building to their wives. In addition, they transferred whatever remaining interest they had in their homes and "the West Bountiful Property" to their wives.

have stipulated to a Writ of Attachment on the Idaho Property. A substantial likelihood exists that Grazer will prevail on the merits of the Utah case as indicated by the Utah Court at the close of the evidence on April 29, 2005. I.C. 8-503(2); Affidavit of Allen F. Grazer, 9. Mr. Grazer's claim for damages is in excess of \$2,000,000.00 in the Utah Case; however, the matter is still under advisement before the Utah Court. Affidavit of Allen F. Grazer, 10. Payment of the expected judgment has not been secured by a mortgage, deed or trust, security interest or lien upon real or personal property. I.C. 8-503(1); Affidavit of Allen F. Grazer, 13.

Jones is attempting to assign, dispose of, or conceal property with the intent to defraud creditors. After learning of the extent of his personal liability in this case in November 2004 and immediately after the Court set the trial in this case, Jones transferred his Idaho ranch (and water rights) to a newlyformed LLC over which he has maintained control. See Exhibits "B" and "C." A complaint under the Uniform Fraudulent Transfer Act and a Lis Pendens have been filed with this Court.

Similarly, a complaint under the Uniform Fraudulent Transfer Act and Lis Pendens have been filed with a court in





Utah for transfers of his property in Utah. See Exhibits "E" and "F."

CONCLUSION

Based upon the Application and Affidavit of Allen Grazer and the Stipulation of the parties to attaching the Idaho ranch without security by Plaintiff, an immediate Prejudgment Writ of Attachment should be issued, no security being required by Plaintiff.





tractor, built a home for Grazer in Davis County, Utah.

13. On November 1, 2002, Jones and Barney initiated litigation against Grazer seek-

ing to collect approximately \$42,000.00 of unpaid invoices. Grazer counterclaimed alleging



construction defects, negligence, and breaches of contract and warranty. This action is known as *Gordon Jones and Richard Barney v. Allen Grazer*, Second District Court, Davis County, Farmington Department, State of Utah, Case No. 020700570 CN ("the Civil Case").

14. On or about March 3, 2005, a Final Order of Condemnation was recorded with the Davis County Recorder against the Condemned Parcels, as Entry No. 2055978 in Book 3738 at Page 296 of Official Records, and Gordon A. Jones Construction, Gordon Jones Construction, Gordon A. Jones, Linda G. Jones, and Richard H. Barney received \$178,000.00 on or about February 11, 2005 as payment on the judgment. The Final Order of Condemnation was entered in an action known as *Utah Department of Transportation v. Gordon A. Jones Construction*, Second District Court, Davis County, Farmington Department, State of Utah, Case No. 010700265 ("the Condemnation Case").

15. Shortly after receiving the proceeds from the Condemnation Case, on or about March 8, 2005, the Trust Deed Note to Barnes Banking Company was paid in full on the Apartment Building and a Deed of Reconveyance was recorded with the Davis County Recorder on or about March 18, 2005 as Entry No. 2059773 in Book 3748 at Page 670 of Official Records.

16. Upon information and belief, the proceeds from the Condemnation Case, in the condemnation of the Condemned Parcels, were used to pay off the Trust Deed Note on the Apartment Building.

17. On April 26-29, 2005 Judge Allphin of the Second District Court in Utah heard the Civil Case. On April 26, 2005 Judge Allphin dismissed the claims brought by Jones and Barney and ruled in favor of Grazer on Jones' and Barney's claims. On April 29, 2005 Judge Allphin declared his preliminary intention to award judgment in favor of Grazer and against Jones and Barney on Grazer's counterclaim. That judgment has not yet been entered, pending arguments by counsel respecting the amount of damages to be awarded.

CLAIM FOR RELIEF

(Fraudulent Transfer)

18. Grazer realleges and incorporates by reference paragraphs 1 through 17 above.

19. Gordon A. Jones and Richard H. Barney executed a quit claim deed, on or about May 6, 2005, transferring the Apartment Building to their wives Linda G. Jones and Renae Carnon Barney within days of Judge Allphin's announcement of his intended verdict in the Civil Case.


20. At the same time, Gordon A. Jones' wife, Linda G. Jones, quit claimed her interest in the Apartment Building to the Linda G. Jones Family Partnership.

21. Gordon A. Jones and Richard H. Barney transferred the Apartment Building to their wives, and Linda G. Jones transferred the Apartment Building to her family partnership, with actual intent to hinder, delay, and defraud Grazer in the collection of a judgment.

22. Linda G. Jones and Renae Carnon Barney are definitionally "insiders" for purposes of the Uniform Fraudulent Transfer Act, <u>Utah Code Ann.</u> § 25-6-2(7)(a)(i). Similarly, the Linda G. Jones Family Partnership is an insider under <u>Utah Code Ann.</u> § 25-6-2(7)(a)(iii).

23. At the time of the quit claim deeds, Defendants had actual knowledge of Judge Allphin's intended verdict and believed or reasonably should have believed that a judgment was imminent.

. . .



25. Grazer is entitled to an avoidance of the transfer to the extent necessary to satisfy his judgment.

26. This Court should attach the Apartment Building pursuant to <u>Utah Code Ann.</u>§ 25-6-8(b).

27. Defendants and each of them should be enjoined from further disposing of property, real and personal, held in Davis County, State of Utah, or elsewhere.

28. Upon information and belief, pursuant to the provisions of the parties' contract,Mr. Grazer is entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and costs in pursuing this action.

29. The Defendants' fraudulent transfers were not in good faith. Pursuant to <u>Utah</u> <u>Code Ann.</u> § 78-27-56, Mr. Grazer is entitled to reasonable attorney's fees to be awarded for the use and benefit of his counsel.

WHEREFORE Plaintiff prays for relief as follows:

A. For judgment avoiding the transfer of the Apartment Building from Gordon A. Jones and Richard H. Barney to their wives and to the Linda G. Jones Family Partnership under the Uniform Fraudulent Transfer Act, <u>Utah Code Ann.</u> § 25-6-8(1)(a)(1988).

B. For a writ of attachment attaching the Apartment Building to satisfy Grazer's judgment against Gordon A. Jones and Richard H. Barney.





C. For an injunction prohibiting Gordon A. Jones and Richard H. Barney from further disposing of property, real and personal, held in Davis County, State of Utah, and elsewhere.

D. For attorneys' fees and costs.

E. For such other and further relief as this Court deems just and equitable.





5. I filed a counterclaim against Mr. Jones in Utah, <u>Gordon Jones and Richard Barney v. Allen Grazer; Allen F. Grazer</u> <u>v. Gordon A. Jones and Richard Barney</u>, Second Judicial District Court of Davis County, Farmington Department, Civil No. 020700570 CN, Judge Michael G. Allphin (the "Utah Case") for defective construction to my home. In late 2004 my experts and I began to discover significant construction defects in the home, and by and through my counsel, began advising counsel for Jones of the severity of these defects.





6. This Notice of Removal is filed within ninety (90) days of the Petition Date and is therefore timely removed pursuant to Rule 9027(a)(2).

7. A copy of the Complaint ("Complaint") filed in Sixth District Court in this matter is attached hereto as Exhibit "A," which is the only pleading currently in the Trustee's possession. The Trustee is in the process of obtaining copies of additional process and pleadings from the clerk of the state court. The Trustee will file the additional documents with this Court upon his receipt.

Plaintiff hereby complains of Defendants as follows:

1. This is an action under the Uniform Fraudulent Transfer Act, Title 55, Chapter 9 of the Idaho Code. In anticipation of judgment, Defendants Gordon A. and Linda G. Jones formed a limited liability company and transferred real property located in Franklin County, Idaho to that LLC. This action seeks to



avoid the transfer, attach the property and enjoin further disposition by Defendants of the Franklin County property or of other property.

PARTIES AND JURISDICTION

2. Plaintiff Allen Grazer is an individual residing in Davis County, State of Utah.

3. Defendants Gordon A. Jones and Linda G. Jones (collectively "Jones") are husband and wife residing in Davis County, State of Utah. Prior to December 28, 2004 Jones owned real property in Franklin County, State of Idaho.

4. Defendant J&J Livestock, LLC is a Utah Limited Liability Company in good standing in the state of Utah. J&J Livestock, LLC owns real property in Franklin County, State of Idaho.

Jurisdiction over Defendants is proper under I.C.
 5-514c(c).

6. Venue is proper in this county under I.C. 5-401(1).

GENERAL ALLEGATIONS

7. Beginning in 2002, Jones owned over 200 acres of land in Franklin County, Idaho. These parcels are identified as Parcels Nos. 908.00, 908.01 and 915.00 with the legal description:





COMMENCING AT A POINT 53-3/4 RODS NORTH OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST OF THE BOISE MERIDIAN, FRANKLIN COUNTY, IDAHO, AND RUNNING THENCE WEST 240 RODS, THENCE NORTH 53-3/4 RODS, THENCE EAST 240 RODS; THENCE SOUTH 53-3/4 RODS TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING.

TOGETHER WITH 36 SHARES OF THE CAPITAL STOCK OF TWIN LAKES CANAL COMPANY.

(hereinafter "the Franklin County property").

8. Commencing in 1993 Jones, as general contractor, built a home for Grazer in Davis County, Utah.

9. On November 1, 2002 Jones initiated litigation against Grazer seeking to collect approximately \$17,000 of unpaid invoices. Grazer counterclaimed alleging construction defects, negligence and breaches of contract and warranty. This action is known as Gordon Jones and Richard Barney v. Allen Grazer, Second District Court, Davis County, Farmington Department, State of Utah, Case No. 020700570 CN ("the civil case").

10. The parties commenced the discovery phase of the civil case. In late 2004 Grazer and his experts began to discuss significant construction defects in the home, and began advising counsel for Gordon Jones of the severity of these defects.

11. On December 15, 2004, the Judge in the civil case sent a notice of trial, scheduling the matter for trial on April 26-29, 2005.

12. On December 22, 2004 Jones transferred, by quit claim deed, the Franklin County property to J&J Livestock, LLC. See Exhibit "A" ("the quit claim deed"). The deed was recorded on December 27, 2004.

13. J&J Livestock, LLC was formed in the state of Utah on December 28, 2004.

14. On April 26-29, 2005 Judge Alphin of the Second District Court in Utah heard the civil case. On April 26, 2005 Judge Alphin dismissed the claims brought by Jones and ruled in favor of Grazer on Jones' claims. On April 29, 2005 Judge Alphin declared his preliminary intention to award judgment in favor of Grazer and against Jones on Grazer's counterclaim. That

judgment has not yet been entered, pending arguments by counsel respecting the amount of damages to be awarded.

FIRST CLAIM FOR RELIEF (Declaratory Judgment)

15. Grazer realleges and incorporates by reference paragraphs 1 - 14 above.

16. The quit claim deed from Jones to J&J Livestock, LLC was recorded on December 27, 2004.

17. J&J Livestock, LLC did not exist until December 28,2004. See Exhibit "A."

18. The quit claim deed, which purports to transfer all right, title and interest in the Franklin County property is void ab initio.

19. This court has the power under the Uniform Declaratory Judgment Act, I.C. 10-1201 *et seq*. to declare the deed void and to declare title to the Franklin County property remains in Jones, grantors under the quit claim deed.

SECOND CLAIM FOR RELIEF (Uniform Fraudulent Transfer Act)

20. Grazer realleges and incorporates by reference paragraphs 1 - 19 above.

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21. As manager, member and registered agent, Jones materially controls, and at all times material hereto has controlled, J&J Livestock, LLC.

22. J&J Livestock, LLC was formed for the purpose of holding title to the Franklin County property.

23. Jones' quit claim deed to J&J Livestock, LLC was made at a time in discovery when Jones became aware of the extent of his potential and likely liability to Grazer.

24. Jones transferred the Franklin County property to J&J Livestock, LLC with actual intent to hinder, delay and defraud Grazer in the collection of a judgment.

25. At the time of the quit claim deed, Jones had received Grazer's expert's report, was facing a trial date on Grazer's claims and believed or reasonably should have believed that a judgment was imminent.

26. On information and belief, Jones did not receive a reasonably equivalent value in exchange for the transfer to J&J Livestock, LLC.

27. Grazer is entitled to an avoidance of the transfer to the extent necessary to satisfy his judgment.





28. This Court should attach the Franklin County property pursuant to I.C. 55-916(b).

29. Defendants and each of them should be enjoined from further disposing of property, real and personal, held in Franklin County, State of Idaho.

WHEREFORE Plaintiff prays for relief as follows:

 For a declaratory order declaring the quit claim deed void ab initio and vesting title to the Franklin County property in Jones.

2. For judgment avoiding the transfer of the Franklin County property from Jones to J&J Livestock, LLC under the Uniform Fraudulent Transfer Act, I.C. 55-916(a).

3. For a writ of attachment attaching the Franklin County property to satisfy Grazer's judgment against Jones.

4. For an injunction prohibiting Jones, J&J Livestock, LLC and each of them from further disposing of property, real and personal held in Franklin County, State of Idaho.

5. For attorneys' fees and costs pursuant to (I.C. 12-121, 10-1201) and the parties' contract.



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6. For such other and further relief as this Court deems just and equitable.

Other appearances, if any, were noted on the record

The Court having reviewed the pleadings on file, admitting evidence and hearing arguments presented, entered detailed findings of fact and conclusions of law on the record, which findings and conclusions are incorporated herein, and include, but are not limited to, the following:

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS:

- Gordon A. Jones, d/b/a J&J Livestock, d/b a Gordon Jones Construction, L.C. (the "Debtor") filed a voluntary petition under Chapter 7 of the Bankruptcy Code on April 18, 2006, commencing Case Number 06-21277 (the "Bankruptcy Case") in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah ("Bankruptcy Court"). Gary Jubber (the "Trustee") is the duly appointed and acting Chapter 7 Trustee of the Debtor's bankruptcy estate.
- 2. That notice of the Motion and the hearing thereon was properly given to the Debtor and all parties-in-interest as required under the Bankruptcy Code or the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure.








- 3. Objections to the Motion were filed by the Debtor and by the Estate of Richard Barney. The Objections are overruled.
- 4. The Settlement Agreement was negotiated at arms' length and in good faith.
- 5. The Trustee's entry into the Settlement Agreement as a fair, reasonable and proper exercise of the Trustee's business judgment.
- 6. The Settlement Agreement and the relief requested in the Motion are reasonable, fair, equitable and in the best interest of the estate and its creditors.
- 7. That in considering this matter, the Court has reviewed and applied the standards set forth in the case of <u>In re Kopexa Realty Venture Co.</u>, 213 B.R. 1020, 1022 (10th Cir. BAP 1997).

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Motion is granted and the Settlement Agreement is approved;

2. The Trustee is authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary and appropriate to effect, implement and consummate the Settlement Agreement. Except for the reserves set forth in the Settlement Agreement, the Trustee is authorized to abandon all property of the estate, as provided in the Settlement Agreement, and Grazer shall be deemed to have relief from the stay to pursue any and all state court remedies with respect to such property. 



In the event a case cannot be tried on the date indicated, every effort will be made to reset at the earliest date available to court and the parties.

2. SCHEDULING CONFLICTS:

Requested continuance of trial setting because of pre-existing scheduling conflict shall be by written motion, state specifically the details of the conflict, and be filed within 14 days hereof.

Requests and/or stipulations for continuances for other than pre-existing conflicts must be in writing, state the specific reason therefore, be <u>approved by the client</u>, propose mutually agreeable times for rescheduling, and are subject to approval by the court.

3. SETTLEMENT:

In the event of settlement of this cause prior to trial, **NOTICE SHALL BE GIVEN TO THE JUDGE <u>AND</u> TO THE CLERK OF THE COURT FORTHWITH. Expenses of the jury incurred because lack of reasonable notice will be assessed to the responsible party or parties.**

* * PRE-TRIAL SCHEDULE * *

The pre-trial schedule for this cause shall be as follows:

1. <u>30 DAYS FROM TODAY'S DATE</u> - DISCLOSURE OF WITNESSES:

Plaintiff shall disclose in writing to Defendant a complete list of all witnesses, expert and lay, which that party intends to call at trial, together with a summary of the testimony of each. Once disclosure from Plaintiff has been received Defendant shall have 30 days to disclose their witnesses.

2. <u>30 DAYS BEFORE TRIAL</u> - DISCLOSURE OF EXHIBITS:

Each party shall disclose, in writing, to all other parties, and the court, a complete list of all exhibits, with a summary of the points to be proven, with a copy attached, which that party intends to use at trial.

3. <u>60 DAYS BEFORE TRIAL</u> - DISCOVERY COMPLETION:

<u>All discovery shall be completed.</u> Discovery requests shall have been served sufficiently in advance of this date to require responses to such requests to be filed by this date. Motions for compulsion, sanctions and/or extensions will be filed in





advance of this date.

4. OCTOBER 9, 2008 - MOTIONS FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT:

I. R. C. P. rule 56(b) shall control the filing of Motions for Summary Judgment and briefing schedule.

5. OCTOBER 9, 2008 - MOTION DEADLINE:

Except for motions for summary judgment, as set out above, and motions directly related to trial procedure, no motions shall be filed after this date. In addition to other requirements of the Rules, or of Orders of this Court, if any, all motions filed with this Court must be supported by a <u>memorandum of position and authorities</u>. Adverse parties shall oppose in the same manner.

6. <u>6 WEEKS BEFORE TRIAL</u> - PRE-TRIAL CONFERENCE OF PARTIES:

Counsel, and any unrepresented party, **shall hold a pre-trial conference** in an effort to resolve the action or to prepare a definitive pre-trial order and plan for trial. Each party shall be prepared to fully discuss each issue and defense presented by the case. The parties shall fully consider the requirements of I.R.C.P. rule 16. This conference **will be held** at the office of the plaintiff's counsel unless otherwise agreed. **Plaintiff's counsel** shall take the lead in organizing and presenting discussion.

Exhibits shall be pre-marked (numerically for plaintiff and alphabetically for defendant. An index of all exhibits shall be prepared showing number/letter, offering party, brief description, and whether offered without objection, or if not, the legal grounds for objection.

7. <u>4 WEEKS BEFORE TRIAL</u> - PRE-TRIAL REPORT AND PROPOSED ORDER:

The parties shall file a report of their pre-trial conference, including any stipulations of the parties, and a proposed order, substantially covering those matters contemplated by I.R.C.P. rule 16(e)(6)(A) through (K). The report shall include the index of pre-marked exhibits. **Plaintiff's counsel** shall take the lead in drafting the report and proposed order. Any party disagreeing with the content shall submit a separate report identifying the area(s) of disagreement with explanation of differences.

8. <u>2 WEEKS BEFORE TRIAL</u> - BRIEFS - EXHIBIT COPIES:

Pre-trial **POINTS AND AUTHORITIES** on all substantive, procedural or evidentiary issues anticipated shall be filed.

Each party shall furnish the court with a <u>copy</u> of each exhibit capable of being copied, in a binder, and tabbed for reference. A tabbed insert sheet, summarizing any exhibit not capable of being copied, shall be included.

Pursuant to Rule 16, I.R.C.P, a formal Pre-trial Conference shall be held on



October 9, 2008 at 1:30 p.m.

** BENCH TRIAL **

9. <u>14 DAYS BEFORE BENCH TRIAL</u> - PROPOSED FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

<u>Unless</u> Findings and Conclusions are <u>waived by mutual stipulation</u> of the parties, proposed **FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW** will be filed by each party. The court will not proceed to trial without them. Sanctions will be imposed for delay.

Proposed findings shall be concise and shall recite ultimate rather than mere evidentiary facts. They will serve not only as suggested findings of fact but also a convenient recitation of contentions of the respective parties to be before the court as it hears and considers the evidence.

Proposed conclusions of law should be similarly concise and reflect those that can be drawn reasonably from the proposed findings of fact, and that would support the judgment or decisions sought. Citation of authority should not be included but shall be submitted separately as Points and Authorities.

DEFENDANT GORDON A. JONES' MOTION TO DISMISS

COMES NOW, Defendant Gordon A. Jones by and through his attorney of record, Lane V. Erickson, and pursuant to Rules 12(b)(1), (3), and (6), and recent rulings in the United State Bankruptcy Court, for the District of Utah involving the above-captioned parties; hereby moves this Court to Dismiss the above-captioned proceedings, including any and all causes of action raised by Plaintiff against Defendants, GORDON A. JONES, an individual; LINDA G. JONES, an individual, and J&J LIVESTOCK, LLC, a Utah limited liability company (hereafter collectively referred to as "Defendants"). Defendants Gordon A. Jones' Motion to Dismiss is based upon the grounds and for the reasons that any and all causes of action raised by Plaintiff against the





Defendants are forever barred by applicable Bankruptcy law. All the facts and circumstances supporting this Motion to Dismiss are evidenced by the Affidavit of Lane V. Erickson in Support of Defendants Gordon A. Jones' Motion to Dismiss, (hereafter "Erickson Affidavit") and by the rulings, decisions, and judgments made and entered in the Utah state court and Utah bankruptcy court proceedings and are as follows:

1. Prior to April 26, 2005, the Defendant Gordon A. Jones sued Plaintiff in Utah state court to recover monies claimed to be due and owing for construction and contractor services that were rendered by Defendant Gordon A. Jones to the Plaintiff in the construction of a residential home for Plaintiff. Said litigation was designated as Davis County District Court Case No. 020700570CN.

2. In the course of this litigation Plaintiff countersued Defendant Gordon A. Jones for breach of contract. Trial was commenced in the above litigation before the Honorable Michael G. Allphin from April 26, 2005 through April 29, 2005. Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law were entered by Judge Allphin on June 17, 2005. On July 11, 2005, a "Judgment Against Counterclaim Defendants Gordon A. Jones and Richard Barney" was entered by Judge Allphin. A true and correct copy of said Judgment is attached to the Affidavit of Lane V. Erickson as Exhibit "A" and is incorporated herein by reference as if set forth fully.

3. On May 12, 2005, Plaintiff filed the present litigation in the Sixth District, Franklin County Court alleging among other things that Defendant Gordon A. Jones had fraudulently transferred property in an attempt to avoid the judgment that was rendered against him by Judge Allphin in the above-described Utah state court litigation. A true and correct copy of the Court Docket for the present case is attached to the Erickson Affidavit as Exhibit "B" and is incorporated

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herein by reference as if set forth fully.

4. In support of his claims against Defendant Gordon A. Jones, the Plaintiff filed a Notice of Filing Foreign Judgment on August 1, 2005, wherein he lodged with this Court a copy of the judgment rendered by Judge Allphin in the Utah state court litigation.

5. As a result of the Utah state court judgment entered by Judge Allphin, described more fully above, on April 18, 2006 Defendant Gordon A. Jones filed a Chapter 7 Bankruptcy in U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah, as Case No. 06-21277. A true and correct copy of the Docket for the Chapter 7 Bankruptcy of Defendant Gordon A. Jones is attached to the Erickson Affidavit as Exhibit "C" and is incorporated herein by reference as if set forth fully.

6. The filing of the Chapter 7 Bankruptcy by Defendant Gordon A. Jones operated as a Stay in the present litigation pursuant to Federal Bankruptcy Code 11 U.S.C. § 362.

7. On May 30, 2006, and again on January 8, 2007, Chapter 7 Bankruptcy Trustee Gary E. Jubber filed a Notice of Removal of Civil Action, in the present litigation. See Docket entries on Exhibit "B".

8. On July 28, 2006, pursuant to applicable Bankruptcy Code sections, Plaintiff filed an Adversary Action against Defendant Gordon A. Jones for the purpose of obtaining a Judgment against Defendant Gordon A. Jones that would allow Plaintiff to pursue his claims in the present case. Said Adversary Action was filed as Adversary Proceeding No. 06-02411 and was assigned to the Honorable Judith A. Boulden, U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah.

9. While this occurred, the present case filed by Plaintiff in the Sixth District, Franklin County was assigned and reassigned to several judges who for various reasons disqualified themselves. 10. On January 20, 2009, U.S. Bankruptcy Judge Judith A. Boulden entered an Order Dismissing the above described Adversary Proceedings due to Plaintiff's having failed to properly prosecute the case by failing to file a proposed pretrial order or seek an extension of the deadline for doing so. A true and correct copy of Judge Boulden's Order Dismissing Adversary Proceeding is attached to the Erickson Affidavit as Exhibit "D" and is incorporated herein by reference as if set forth fully.


11. Also on January 20, 2009, U.S. Bankruptcy Judge Judith A. Boulden entered an Order granting the Discharge of Debtor, who was the Defendant Gordon A. Jones. A true and correct copy of said Discharge of Debtor is attached to the Erickson Affidavit as Exhibit "E" and is incorporated herein by reference as if set forth fully.

12. Pursuant to Federal Bankruptcy Code 11 U.S.C. 727, Defendant Gordon A. Jones, as the Debtor, is forever discharged of any and all debts that arose prior to his filing bankruptcy. As a result of this discharge, Plaintiff is barred from seeking to recover under the Utah State Court Judgment attached to the Erickson Affidavit as Exhibit "A".

13. By reason of the decisions, orders, and granting of the discharge to Defendant Gordon A. Jones by the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah, Plaintiff has no "Foreign Judgment" upon which he can rely in the present case. Additionally, none of the causes of action based upon this Foreign Judgment can now form a valid cause of action against Defendant Gordon A. Jones without being a violation of the Discharge of Debtor order attached to the Erickson Affidavit as Exhibit "E".

WHEREFORE, based upon the facts and for the reasons set forth above, the undersigned requests that its Motion to Dismiss be granted without further hearing or argument so as to avoid






5. In support of his claims against Defendant Gordon A. Jones, the Plaintiff filed a Notice of Filing Foreign Judgment on August 1, 2005, wherein he lodged with this Court a copy of the judgment rendered by Judge Allphin in the Utah state court litigation.

6. As a result of the Utah state court judgment entered by Judge Allphin, described more fully above, on April 18, 2006 Defendant Gordon A. Jones filed a Chapter 7 Bankruptcy in U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah, as Case No. 06-21277. A true and correct copy of the Docket for the Chapter 7 Bankruptcy of Defendant Gordon A. Jones is attached hereto as Exhibit "C" and is incorporated herein by reference as if set forth fully.

7. The filing of the Chapter 7 Bankruptcy by Defendant Gordon A. Jones operated as a Stay in the present litigation pursuant to Federal Bankruptcy Code 11 U.S.C. § 362.

8. On May 30, 2006, and again on January 8, 2007, Chapter 7 Bankruptcy Trustee Gary E. Jubber filed a Notice of Removal of Civil Action, in the present litigation. See Docket entries on Exhibit "B".

9. On July 28, 2006, pursuant to applicable Bankruptcy Code sections, Plaintiff filed an Adversary Action against Defendant Gordon A. Jones for the purpose of obtaining a Judgment



10. While this occurred, the present case filed by Plaintiff in the Sixth District, Franklin County was assigned and reassigned to several judges who for various reasons disqualified themselves.

11. On January 20, 2009, U.S. Bankruptcy Judge Judith A. Boulden entered an Order Dismissing the above described Adversary Proceedings due to Plaintiff's having failed to properly prosecute the case by failing to file a proposed pretrial order or seek an extension of the deadline for doing so. A true and correct copy of Judge Boulden's Order Dismissing Adversary Proceeding is attached hereto as Exhibit "D" and is incorporated herein by reference as if set forth fully.

12. Also on January 20, 2009, U.S. Bankruptcy Judge Judith A. Boulden entered an Order granting the Discharge of Debtor, who was the Defendant Gordon A. Jones. A true and correct copy of said Discharge of Debtor is attached hereto as Exhibit "E" and is incorporated herein by reference as if set forth fully.

13. Pursuant to Federal Bankruptcy Code 11 U.S.C. 727, Defendant Gordon A. Jones, as the Debtor, is forever discharged of any and all debts that arose prior to his filing bankruptcy.

As a result of this discharge, Plaintiff is barred from seeking to recover under the Utah State Court Judgment attached hereto as Exhibit "A".


14. By reason of the decisions, orders, and granting of the discharge to Defendant Gordon A. Jones by the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah, Plaintiff has no "Foreign Judgment" upon which he can rely in the present case. Additionally, none of the causes of action based upon this Foreign Judgment can now form a valid cause of action against Defendant Gordon A. Jones without being a violation of the Discharge of Debtor order attached hereto as Exhibit "E".







EXPLANATION OF BANKRUPTCY DISCHARGE IN A CHAPTER 7 CASE

This court order grants a discharge to the person named as the debtor. It is not a dismissal of the case and it does not determine how much money, if any, the trustee will pay to creditors.

Collection of Discharged Debts Prohibited

The discharge prohibits any attempt to collect from the debtor a debt that has been discharged. For example, a creditor is not permitted to contact a debtor by mail, phone, or otherwise, to file or continue a lawsuit, to attach wages or other property, or to take any other action to collect a discharged debt from the debtor. [In a case involving community property: There are also special rules that protect certain community property owned by the debtor's spouse, even if that spouse did not file a bankruptcy case.] A creditor who violates this order can be required to pay damages and attorney's fees to the debtor.

However, a creditor may have the right to enforce a valid lien, such as a mortgage or security interest, against the debtor's property after the bankruptcy, if that lien was not avoided or eliminated in the bankruptcy case. Also, a debtor may voluntarily pay any debt that has been discharged.

Debts That are Discharged

The chapter 7 discharge order eliminates a debtor's legal obligation to pay a debt that is discharged. Most, but not all, types of debts are discharged if the debt existed on the date the bankruptcy case was filed. (If this case was begun under a different chapter of the Bankruptcy Code and converted to chapter 7, the discharge applies to debts owed when the bankruptcy case was converted.)

Debts that are Not Discharged.

Some of the common types of debts which are <u>not</u> discharged in a chapter 7 bankruptcy case are:

a. Debts for most taxes;

b. Debts incurred to pay nondischargeable taxes (applies to cases filed on or after 10/17/2005);

c. Debts that are domestic support obligations;

d. Debts for most student loans;

e. Debts for most fines, penalties, forfeitures, or criminal restitution obligations;

f. Debts for personal injuries or death caused by the debtor's operation of a motor vehicle, vessel, or aircraft while intoxicated;

g. Some debts which were not properly listed by the debtor;

h. Debts that the bankruptcy court specifically has decided or will decide in this bankruptcy case are not discharged;

i. Debts for which the debtor has given up the discharge protections by signing a reaffirmation agreement in compliance with the Bankruptcy Code requirements for reaffirmation of debts.

j. Debts owed to certain pension, profit sharing, stock bonus, other retirement plans, or to the Thrift Savings Plan for federal employees for certain types of loans from these plans (applies to cases filed on or after 10/17/2005).

This information is only a general summary of the bankruptcy discharge. There are exceptions to these general rules. Because the law is complicated, you may want to consult an attorney to determine the exact effect of the discharge in this case.

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
