#12 - MISCELLANEOUS INCIDENT:

1. BRIEF SYNOPSIS OF OFFENSE:

On 09/30/15 at approximately 1100 hours, I made contact with CORY, who is an employee at Sportsman's Warehouse. He reported that two subjects came into the store and used fraudulent credit cards to purchase approximately \$6700 worth of property. CORY stated that he was contacted by a Sportsman's store from the Boise area, and they indicated that they had two subjects come into their store with fraudulent credit cards and had been arrested. This matched the incident that occurred in the Pocatello store.

CORY was able to confirm through the emails that the two subjects, later identified as ALBERTO TORRES and ZUATNEY GONZALEZ, were using fictitious credit cards to make large purchases at various Sportsman's Warehouse stores throughout the area. They had been contacted by law enforcement in the Nampa area and were in possession of 39 fraudulent credit cards as well as two fake identifications.

Photos provided by CORY from the Pocatello store matched photos provided by the Nampa store as well as driver's licenses for ALBERTO TORRES CASTILLO and ZUATNEY GONZALEZ.

2. DOCUMENTS OF EVIDENCE TO BE FILED IN RECORDS: (STATEMENTS, RIGHTS FORMS, LATENTS, PHOTOS, ETC)

There will be an email from info@orcaid.org for a retail incident alert from Sportsman's Warehouse in Nampa, Idaho. It includes two pages plus three photographs. The second document will be an incident report from CORY at the Sportsman's Warehouse in Pocatello. This document has nine pages and references ZUATNEY GONZALEZ. The next document is five pages and includes information for ALBERTO TORRES. I also have an email from Detective TOM GERDES with the Nampa Police Department in reference to his investigation with the two suspects. I have driver's license information for ZUATNEY GONZALEZ as well as for ALBERTO TORRES CASTILLO; all will be uploaded to Spillman under this report.

3. VICTIM(S) INTERVIEW(S):

On 09/30/15, I made contact with CORY who is and employee of Sportsman's Warehouse at 760 Yellowstone Avenue. He stated that he has documentation and a report from an incident that occurred on 09/26/15 around 1950 hours. He states that two subjects who were later identified as ALBERTO TORRES and ZUATNEY GONZALEZ entered the store and selected numerous items. CORY said that he was later contacted by a fellow employee out of the Nampa area who indicated that these two subjects had done the same thing at the Nampa store and were currently in police custody. CORY also told me that the suspects had numerous fictitious credit cards as well as fake identifications on their person when they were contacted by law enforcement. CORY said that his reports were broken down and were specific towards each suspect as they had each made a separate purchase at the store. He said that one of them spent \$3760 and the other had spent \$2842.

After speaking with CORY, I remembered that I had received an email from orcaid.org for a retail incident alert out of the Nampa Sportsman's Warehouse where a male and a female were using fraudulent credit cards to purchase property. I also had three photographs. I was able to locate that email and print it off to attach to this report, including the photographs that were supplied.

Upon arrival, I made contact with CORY and he provided me with the two separate incident reports, specific to each individual person. The first report was for ALBERTO TORRES. There was minimal information for TORRES other than a name, but it did have the purchases itemized on the report, totaling \$3125.85. CORY also had a report indicating what had happened and what he had done in his investigation. It indicates that he was made aware of a credit card fraud by District Manager JENNY ROGERS, who is based out of Meridian. She had informed CORY that the incident at his store had taken place on 09/26/15. Two subjects, one male and one female had used a fraudulent credit card to purchase items at approximately 1945 hours.

CORY gathered the information and contacted law enforcement. He was told that the Nampa Police case number referencing the incident that had occurred in Nampa was N15-54859 and that Detective TOM GURDES was investigating that. He also provided me with a second report in reference to ZUATNEY GONZALEZ but said that she goes by the name of "TIFFANY". He states that the itemized list shows a total of \$3547.87. At the end of the report for GONZALEZ, the narrative that he had typed out was identical to the one for TORRES, but he also provided in this report a list of emails between himself and his fellow employees as well as other information that had been passed back and forth between the stores. This information will also be uploaded to Spillman.

After speaking with them, I responded back to the Pocatello Police Department where I was able to make contact with Detective GURDES of the Nampa Police Department. He provided me with names of the subjects as well as dates of birth and driver's license information. Detective GURDES provided a driver's license number out of Florida for ZUATNEY GONZALEZ of G524-980-83-905-1. I was able to run that driver's license number and obtain a photo as well as driver's license information for GONZALEZ. Detective GURDES also provided a date of birth and a Virginia driver's license for ALBERTO CASTILLO and a driver's license number of . I was also able to locate driver's license information as well as a driver's license photograph for him.

The photographs that were provided in CORY'S report from Sportsman's Warehouse in Pocatello had photographs of the suspects. Those photographs appeared to match the subjects that were sent out in the retail incident alert through orcaid.org from the Sportsman's Warehouse in Nampa, Idaho. Detective GURDES is in the process of collecting all of the fictitious credit cards he was able to locate. He states that he currently has 39 of them and is in the process of investigating those. He also has two fake identifications that the subjects had. He indicated that once he has all of the information that he needs, he will contact me and provide me with some of that information to determine whether or not the credit cards used in the incidents that occurred in Pocatello matched the fraudulent credit cards he had located on the subjects in Nampa. At this time there is nothing further and further follow up will be conducted with Detectives from Nampa when that information is available.







MEMORANDUM DECISION AND ORDER

NATURE OF THE CASE

On July 14, 2016, the defendant, Zuatney Gonzalez ("the Defendant" or "Gonzalez"), filed a Motion for Credit for Time Served. The motion requested that this Court grant her credit for time served on her Bannock County case while she was in jail in Canyon County awaiting disposition of her case there. This Court heard oral arguments regarding the Defendant's motion on July 18, 2016. After the hearing, this Court took the matter under advisement. After considering the oral arguments and reviewing the entire file, this Court now issues this Memorandum Decision and Order.

ISSUE

Is the Defendant entitled to credit for time served while in the Canyon County jail?

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On September 28, 2015, Gonzalez was arrested and charged in Canyon County, Idaho, with 12 felony counts consisting of forgery, burglary, grand theft, and criminal possession of a financial transaction card. The Defendant remained incarcerated in Canyon County until her sentencing hearing on March 7, 2016. Gonzalez pled guilty to a single count of burglary and was sentenced to one year fixed, followed by four years indeterminate. At the time of sentencing, the Defendant was granted 162 days of credit for time served on the Canyon County case.

On October 21, 2015, the Bannock County Prosecuting Attorney filed a Criminal Complaint against Gonzalez, charging her with two counts of criminal possession of a financial

transaction card and one count of burglary. On that same date, a magistrate judge set bond at \$25,000.00 and issued an arrest warrant. The Defendant was served with the warrant on March 3, 2016. Ultimately, the Defendant pled guilty to two counts of criminal possession of a financial transaction card and was sentenced to serve a sentence of one year fixed and four years indeterminate. That sentence was ordered to run concurrently with the Canyon County case.

The Defendant now asks that this Court grant her credit for the time she spent in the Canyon County jail prior to being served with the Bannock County warrant.

DISCUSSION

In computing the term of imprisonment, the person against whom the judgment was entered shall receive credit in the judgment for any period of incarceration prior to entry of judgment, if such incarceration was for the offense or an included offense for which the judgment was entered. IDAHO CODE ANN. § 18-309. Credit for time served pertains to the pretrial incarceration of a person charged with a crime but prior to the entry of a conviction. State v. Moliga, 113 Idaho 672, 675, 747 P.2d 81, 84 (Idaho Ct.App.1987)(quoting In re Rojas, 23 Cal.3d 152, 151 Cal.Rptr. 649, 652, 588 P.2d 789, 792 (1979)). The crucial element of the statute is not where or under what conditions the defendant has been deprived of his liberty, but, rather, whether the custody to which he has been subjected is attributable to charges arising from the same criminal act or acts for which the defendant has been convicted. Moliga, 113 Idaho at 675. Idaho Code ("IC") § 18-309 does not authorize credit where the pending proceeding has no effect whatsoever upon a defendant's liberty. Id. Therefore, entitlement to credit under I.C. § 18-309 depends upon the answer to a single question: Was the defendant's incarceration upon the offense for which he was sentenced? If a particular period of confinement served prior to the imposition of sentence is not attributable to the charge or conduct for which a sentence is to be imposed, the offender is not entitled to credit. State v. Hale, 116 Idaho 763, 765, 779 P.2d 438, 440 (Idaho Ct.App.1989).

The Defendant was incarcerated in Canyon County in case number CR-2015-19062-C from September 28, 2015, until her sentencing on March 7, 2016. The district judge in Canyon County granted her credit of 162 days, since the time the Defendant spent in jail in Canyon County was directly attributable to the crimes she committed in that jurisdiction. An arrest warrant was issued in Bannock County on October 21, 2015, and served on the Defendant on March 3, 2016. The Defendant is now requesting that credit for that time be applied to her

Page 2

Bannock County case. However, the time Gonzalez spent in the Canyon County jail from October 21, 2015, to March 3, 2016, is still attributable to her criminal conduct in Canyon County. Gonzalez's incarceration in the Canyon County jail was for an offense other than the one for which she was sentenced in Bannock County; therefore she is not entitled to credit in the Bannock County case for that Canyon County jail time. However, once the Defendant was served with the arrest warrant, it is clear that she was then being held for criminal conduct that allegedly occurred in Bannock County, and she is therefore entitled to credit for time served from March 3, 2016, until May 2, 2016. Thus, the Defendant is entitled to 68 days of credit on her Bannock County case.

CONCLUSION

After careful consideration, this Court <u>DENIES</u> the Defendant's request for credit for time served from October 21, 2015, to March 3, 2016, since she was confined in the Canyon County jail on conduct unrelated to the charges in Bannock County at that time. However, this Court <u>GRANTS</u> the Defendant credit of 62 days, which represents the time spent incarcerated on the charges in Bannock County.

IT IS SO ORDERED this August 1, 2016.


